Mata Jeeto Ji Mother Child Society is a registered charity organization helping homeless, destitute, orphan children, widows, people affected by natural disasters and other needy people from relatively poor economic backgrounds.

Mata Jeeto Ji Society has been helping the needy in Australia and in different parts of India since 2014. Mata Jeeto Ji Society current charity projects include:

- a) Destitute care: Necessary care and welfare of our less fortunate elderly as well as mentally challenged and abandoned.
- b) Helping Homeless in regional NSW to help the needy. Advocating their needs in the difficult times during disaster and pandemic.
- c) Helping families and supporting businesses in natural disaster regional and rural areas.
- d) Orphan Care: Sponsoring children (in terms of providing assistance with school fees, books and stationary), who have lost their parents due to an accident, illness, drug overdose and/or suicide.
- e) Widow support program: Supporting needy widows (from poor economic background) to help raise and educate their children.
- f) Education & Training: Assisting youth & children from underprivileged families to obtain better education and training to self-sustain in their lives.
- g) FREE Stitching Training Centres that provide free hands-on training and Sewing machines to girls from needy families.
- h) FREE dispensary which provides basic medical facilities, first aid and medication for the poor people who cannot afford medicines for their treatment.

- i) Ongoing funding towards the salary of a doctor & nurse caring for destitute, elderly and abandoned at a destitute care center.
- j) Regular & Ongoing FREE medical and general health & environmental awareness camps in regional, economically poor and slum areas.
- k) Childcare & training disabled kids: Providing free day care and required training to physically and mentally disable kids from needy / low economic background families, who cannot afford childcare facilities on their own.
- I) Ongoing support & assistance to help other charitable organizations serving humanity.

Why Mata Jeeto Ji Society does all these humanitarian works?

The individuals and families we cater to at, Mata Jeeto Ji Society, needed assistance to come out from a distress situation (they have been in) when we arrived at their assistance. Some of them could have suffered serious physical and mental health issues if we did not hold their hand at a time when they needed assistance. I cite a few examples as under:

Hundreds of destitute may not have survived and lived a healthy life with dignity without cur assistance in terms of supplies of shelter, food, medicines and other basic necessary care.

Several needy from low socio-economic background and slum areas near Sri Anandpur Sahib would have been worse off without immediate health care, hygiene education & basic medication for their living.

Several orphan children could have been worse off if Mata Jeeto Ji society did not hold their hand for care and education in terms of paying their school fees and other expenses.

Several needy widows may not be able to raise their families with dignity if Mata Jeeto Ji society did not provide regular financial support to these needy. Hundreds of needy girls would not have hands on training and a tool to earn livelihood if Mate Jeeto Ji society did not provide necessary training at the free sewing training centers in low socio-economic areas.

Similarly, the needy individuals would have suffered badly, children would have gone without toys and businesses might have suffered badly if Mata Jeeto Ji society was not there to help out our mates in the drought affected area of Coonamble and Armidale.

The homeless may have slept hungry if Mata jeeto ji society did not go to help them out in this hour of need in Cessnock.

How do we choose the people to receive benevolent relief?

In collaboration with our sister organizations in respective areas and making our independent enquiries, we provide benevolent relief to the poorest of the poor and to the other needy who need it the most. For instance, helping out homeless in Cessnock.

How Mata Jeeto Ji society provides benevolent relief to the needy people?

Mata Jeeto Ji society provides benevolent relief to people as under:

- a) Providing free hands on training and tools to the school dropout girls from low socio-economic background to earn a livelihood and live a life with dignity
- b) Providing financial assistance to the needy to set up their business in order to make them self
- c) sufficient
- d) Providing regular financial assistance to the widows to raise their families and send their children to school
- e) Providing financial assistance to orphan children for their education, uniform, books, stationary and other needs
- f) Providing free medical examination, treatment as well as medicines at the free dispensary for people from low economic backgrounds
- g) By providing an ambulance to transport hit and run, sick and other needy to the nearby hospitals and destitute care centers.
